Kingsley again asked council to consider putting in a 20' gate through town property and a culvert, so that mobile homes and larger buildings could easily move in and out of Robert's Acres. He said he could keep the cost under \$3,000. The initial estimate was \$3,700. Kingsley made a motion to install a gate and culvert on the town's property to allow access for larger buildings with the cost not to exceed \$3,000. Callahan seconded. **Motion passed 2-1.** (Callahan opposed.)

- C. **Garbage Fees** – Kingsley made a motion to charge residents \$50 for oversized trash that exceeds pick-up terms specified in Advanced Disposal's contract. Callahan seconded. **Motion passed 3-0.**
