Aug. 10, 2017**

- I) The meeting was called to order with the reciting of the Lord's Prayer and Pledge to the Flag.

The ordinance is named after Molly, an American box mix, who survived being brutally stabbed and beaten. Molly was at the council meeting and greeted council with thankful licks.
